Minister of Finance Announces Appointment of New Chairman of the Canada Development Investment Corporation

The Honourable Jim Flaherty, Minister of Finance, today announced the appointment of N. William C. Ross as Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Canada Development Investment Corporation (CDIC).
