Legal opinions back fin ban

Toronto councillors pushing for a citywide ban of shark fin waved around two legal opinions Wednesday.

The city's licensing and standards committee will consider a ban Thursday--a day after Mississauga city council unanimously voted to ban shark fin.

If approved Thursday, a bylaw banning shark fin would set out steep fines for those caught with, selling or consuming shark fin products.

The bylaw would slap violators with a \$5,000 fine for a first offence, \$25,000 for a second offence and \$100,000 for a third or subsequent offence.

The two separate legal opinions, one from lawyer George Rust-D'Eye and another from lawyer Nick Wright and signed by 11 other lawyers, state the city has the authority to ban the possession and sale of shark fin products in Toronto.
